Applying a set of interactive methodologies, the trainings will encourage scientists to reflect the following questions:

- What are the benefits and risks of engaging with multiple publics?
- How can I integrate participative elements into my research?
- How can I organize and facilitate citizen- and stakeholder dialogues?
- What kinds of public engagement formats exist and what can I learn from them?

IDEA AND CONCEPT

Every training starts with a qualified input provided by internationally experienced speakers. The number of experts can vary from I to 3. The input section is followed by an interactive session in which the participants will learn and practice new tools and skills they can apply in future research projects and funding proposals.

We offer trainings in English or German for 15 - 40 participants. The costs for each training depend on the size, format and the length of each workshop – we can design trainings between 0,5 to 2 days. Individual offers can be provided upon request.

The trainings can be held in universities, research institutions, doctoral schools or other venues. Target groups are early career researchers from different backgrounds.
